Q. *Do I need to use a Funeral Director?*

A. Most people use a Funeral Director, however, this is not essential. Although the grave would need to be dug professionally

Q. *Can two people be buried in one plot?*

A. No but it may be possible to have adjacent plots if an advanced reservation is made

Q. *Will it always remain a burial ground?*

A. Yes it is completely separate to the farm and will remain a Burial Ground with natural pasture and woodland for perpetuity.

Q. *Please can plaques, memorial stones/seats/vases etc be put on graves?*

A. Trees are the only memorial permitted; our aim is that Mole Valley Green Burial Ground remains a natural and unspoiled environment which provides a natural habitat for all nature and wildlife

Q. Can any type of coffins be used?

No. Only biodegradable, environmentally friendly coffins are to be used e.g. Wicker, felt, cotton shroud, natural wood; no chipboard, metal or plastic

Q. *Can plots be bought in advance?*

A. Yes. If an Advanced Reservation(s) is made for a Burial plot a Legal Deed will be given stating the right to be buried here and also the right of access at any time to the Burial Ground

Q. *Can I have a religious service at the graveside?*

A. Yes. You decide and arrange what type of service you would like: any faith, celebrant or humanist are welcome. Or you may decide to have no service at all with simply readings and remembrances from family and/or friends. It is up to you to arrange the burial how you wish.
